

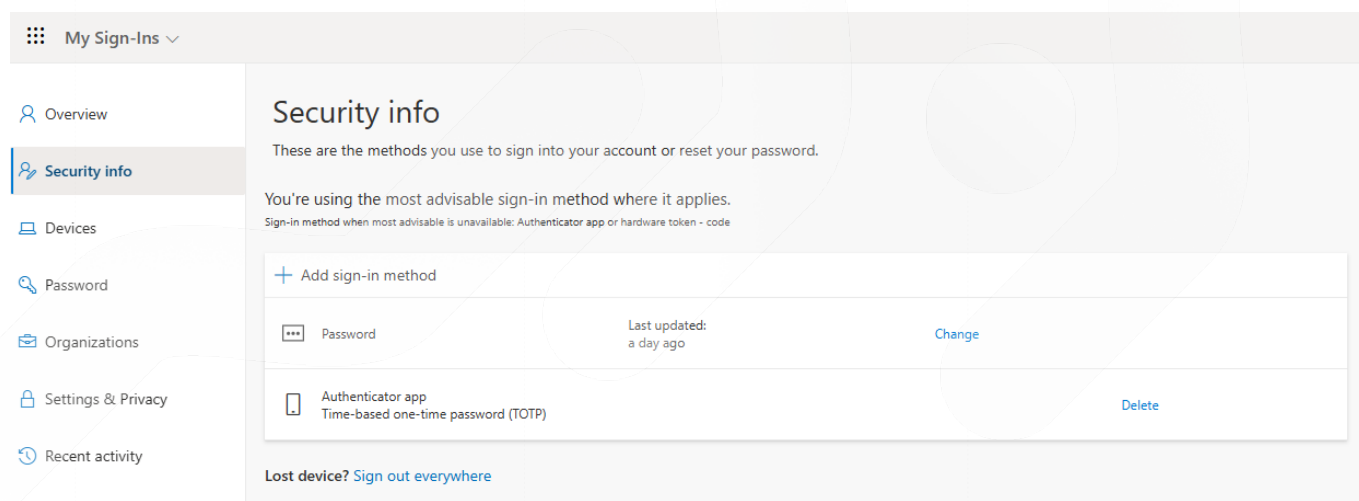

User Token Enrollment Process

From the [My Security Info](#) page, click "**Add sign-in method**".



Select the "**Hardware token**" method from the available options.

Add a sign-in method



Security key

Sign in using a USB, Bluetooth, or NFC device



Microsoft Authenticator

Approve sign-in requests or use one-time codes



Hardware token

Receive a code to reset your password



App password

Use this to sign in to a specific app that requires a password

Next, the user will be prompted to enter the serial number, typically located on the back of the key.

To register the token provided by your organization, start by entering the serial number on your token.



Logging in

Once the TOTP token is activated and set as the default MFA method, users can use it to log in. The login page will prompt for an 'Authenticator Code' and the OTP generated by the hardware token will be accepted seamlessly.
